ABOUT GILGAL

Fruit-forward and expressive, Gilgal wines offer a wide range of varietals that reflect the exceptional Mediterranean climate and growing conditions of the Galilee. These easygoing, approachable wines are sure to please everyone.

THE WINE

Gilgal Red Blend features ripe raspberry, cherry and plum fruit notes, intermingling with nuances of earth, chocolate, flowers and orange zest. Particularly ripe, concentrated and complex, this blended wine displays full body and a lingering finish. Gilgal Red Blend is produced from the classic Bordeaux varieties of Cabernet Sauvignon (65%), Merlot (22%), Petit Verdot (7%), Cabernet Franc (3%) and Malbec (3%). All grapes were grown in vineyards on the Golan Heights and the wine aged in French oak barrels for 12 months

PAIRING

Try pairing this wine with grilled hanger steaks, slow-cooked lamb shanks, or roasted tomato and goat cheese polenta.

ABOUT THE GALILEE APPELLATION

The Galilee (or Galil) is the northernmost — and generally considered the best — appellation in Israel. The highest quality growing area within the appellation is the Golan Heights (or simply the Golan), also the coldest region in Israel. The vineyards on this volcanic plateau rise from 1,300 feet to 3,900 feet above sea level and receive snowfall in the winter. Golan Heights Winery is located in the town of Katzrin in the central Golan.
