Yarden is the premier label and flagship brand of Golan Heights Winery. Each year, the finest grapes from the best vineyards are reserved for Yarden wines. “Yarden” is the Hebrew word for Jordan River, which bisects the Golan Heights from the Galilee. The label features a symbol of ancient Israel: an oil lamp decorated with mosaic tile.

THE WINE

The 2021 Yarden Pinot Noir presents appealing aromas of ripe strawberries and violets, intermingling with mixed spice and hints of earth. With light-to-medium body, this aromatic and complex wine is satisfyingly flavorful. Enjoyable upon release, the 2021 Yarden Pinot Noir will develop in the bottle over a few years and stay in outstanding drinking shape for some five to eight years from harvest. Try pairing this food-friendly wine with pan-fried lamb tenderloin, grilled salmon fillets, or caramelized onion and Parmesan risotto.

THE VINTAGE

2021 was another noteworthy vintage in the shadow of the coronavirus pandemic, and our fantastic team once again rose to the challenge. Winter was characterized by average rainfall, with warmer-than-average temperatures in both winter and spring. About a month after starting harvest on August 1, the week spanning late August and early September was our fourth heaviest week ever in our 39 vintages. We completed the harvest in mid-October, capping off a relatively short 11-week season. Our yields, which were a modest 7% below normal, were balanced by very high quality. All in all, the 2021 vintage saw beautiful results across all of our varieties

ABOUT THE GALILEE APPELLATION

The Galilee (or Galil) is the northernmost — and generally considered the best — appellation in Israel. The highest quality growing area within the appellation is the Golan Heights (or simply the Golan), also the coldest region in Israel. The vineyards on this volcanic plateau rise from 1,300 feet to 3,900 feet above sea level and receive snowfall in the winter. Golan Heights Winery is located in the town of Katzrin in the central Golan.
