THE WINE

The 2021 Yarden Bar'on Vineyard presents a rich tapestry of aromas and flavors including ripe black fruits, chocolate, earth, smoke, tobacco and hints of potpourri. Displaying full body and concentrated flavor, this single-vineyard wine is a great choice for special occasions, whether momentous or intimate. The wine is aged for 19 months in French oak barrels. We love pairing this festive wine with a rich osso buco, garlicky slow-roasted lamb shoulder, or a creamy lentil and mushroom stew.

Golan Heights Winery has always focused on in-depth study and research of their terroir to match the best varieties with their vineyards. BAR'ON VINEYARD

The 2021 Yarden Bar'on Vineyard is blended from 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 19% Syrah and 11% Petit Verdot grown exclusively in Bar'on Vineyard. As these percentages reflect the proportions of the three red varieties grown in the vineyard, the wine provides unique insight into the high-quality Bar'on Vineyard. Certified sustainable, this vineyard is situated at an elevation of 1,040 meters (3,400 feet) in the northern Golan Heights.

ABOUT THE GALILEE APPELLATION

The Galilee (or Galil) is the northernmost — and generally considered the best — appellation in Israel. The highest quality growing area within the appellation is the Golan Heights (or simply the Golan), also the coldest region in Israel. The vineyards on this volcanic plateau rise from 1,300 feet to 3,900 feet above sea level and receive snowfall in the winter. Golan Heights Winery is located in the town of Katzrin in the central Golan.
